## SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT

Symptom management, including pain management, is the central goal of hospice. Our staff is trained to look for signs of discomfort, both physical and emotional. We are constantly assessing the patient's symptoms and developing plans to give the patient maximum comfort.



## BEREAVEMENT

As a leader in hospice care, we are committed to providing information, counseling, and resources to those who have lost a loved one. Our support groups and counseling services are available for a year or more after your loved one has passed.

## RESPIRE CARE

Respite care is available for patients and caregivers when time away is needed. Patients are cared for in a contracted facility for up to 5 days while the hospice team continues services. Respite care for a caregiver can help prevent stress, depression, burnout, and fatigue.

## PAYMENT

Medicare, Medicaid, and/or private insurance will likely cover your hospice care needs with no out-of-pocket cost. This covers your hospice care team as well as medications, supplies, and durable medical equipment when needed.
